

2010 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to graduate from West Burlington Arnold High School **in 2010**, a student must earn the designated credit minimum and maintain a cumulative grade of 1.0 or higher. A credit is earned for the successful completion of a course that meets for a block all semester. The Board of Education has established the following requirements to be included within the designated credit minimum:



Students need 54 credits to graduate

All students must enroll in 7.5 credits per semester (15 per year).

Mathematics	6	(to be exclusive of computer science courses)
Science	4	(must include Unified Science and Biology I)
English	8	(must include English 9, English 10, American Literature, and Speech)
Social Studies	6	(must include American History I and II, Federal Government)
Family Consumer Science and/or Industrial Technology	2	
Physical Education & Health	5	(P.E. each year for 4 credits and 1 credit of Health)
Keyboarding	1	
Workplace Readiness	1

- One credit equals one semester course
- P.E. is one credit all year (meets every other day)
